APPLICATION SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Complete the application in its entirety.

Submit two (2) sets of three (3) photos of your engraved work with the application form.

- Photos submitted should be produced on high quality photographic paper. Both matte and glossy finishes are acceptable. Photos submitted by any other means such as on CD or via email will not be accepted. Photos will not be returned unless accompanied by a self addressed, stamped envelope.
- Photos must show quality artistic work, potentially qualifying you for the course.
- Each photo should contain only one view of one piece of work.
- Photos must not have names or other personally identifiable information on them. Photos received with any identifiable marks will be 'edited' and all such information blocked out. This may affect the presentation of the work.

After the closing date for receipt of applications, all candidates' photos will be reviewed to remove any names or other identifying marks. They will then be assigned a number known only to Glendo management. Photos will be sent to the course instructors who will select 12 students based on the work shown in the photos. Three alternates will also be selected to cover possible cancellations. Applications are kept confidential to ensure selections are unbiased. Instructors do not have access to names until after the selection process.

All applications must be received no later than April 30, 2010. Applicants will be notified by May 15, 2010 whether they have been selected for inclusion.

FEES AND PAYMENT

Prices are in US dollar amounts. The fee for the course is \$2595. However, payment is not required until you have been notified of acceptance to the class. After that time, two (2) payments will be required. The first payment is due on June 1, 2010, in the amount of \$1300. The second payment is due on July 1, 2010, in the amount of \$1295. Payments may be paid via credit card, money order, or check. Cancellation after June 1 will result in the forfeiture of all payments received.
